

KERALA HOME LOAN SUICIDES

Police find note blaming husband, 4 of family arrested

A DAY after it emerged that a mother-daughter duo killed themselves over recovery proceedings following the family's failure to repay their home loan, the police on Wednesday said they have found the woman's suicide note blaming her husband and other family members for their death.

Lekha blamed Chandran for "performing black magic" instead of taking any concrete steps to clear the dues.

The protests against Canara Bank, which had initiated recovery proceedings against Chandran, subsided with the arrests.

However, three of the bank's offices, including its regional office in Thiruvananthapuram, have

been vandalised by irate residents.

Police and revenue department had earlier found that Lekha and Vaishnavi were forced to take the extreme step as the bank had set a deadline for repaying the loan of Rs 7 lakh.

The state government has sought a report from the bank. Investigating officer Biju Nair said those arrested have not confessed to the crime yet.

He said the suicide note would be subjected to scientific examination.

According to the suicide note purportedly written by Lekha and found pasted on a wall of the residence Wednesday morning, Chandran used to perform "black magic" at his home.

"Poojas were performed behind the house, where notices

from the bank were placed at a structure raised for black magic. He had never gone to the bank to enquire about the notices served over loan. Krishnamma had objected to the sale of house to clear the loan dues."

Local panchayat member G Ramesh Kumar said that Chandran had been in the Middle East for nearly a decade. "He returned nine months back. Since then, he has been working as carpenter in the region. We were all aware about his outstanding housing loan and the bid to sell off the house to repay the loan. Now, we suspect that he was not keen to repay the defaulted loan at the behest of his mother. He used to perform witchcraft behind his house and did not socialise with local people," said Kumar.

FIR against BJP, Cong MLAs in Haryana for 'entering booths'

THE HARYANA police on Wednesday registered an FIR against Minister of State for Cooperatives and BJP MLA from Rohtak Manish Grover, for allegedly intimidating voters by entering polling booths on May 12 — the day the Lok Sabha polls ended in the state.

Former Congress MLA from Rohtak BB Batra, who had entered into a heated exchange of words with Grover in one of the polling booths, was also booked for unauthorised entry.

"A case has been registered against both Manish Grover and BB Batra. A special investigation team has been constituted to further investigate," Yash Garg, Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak told The Indian Express.

On Tuesday, senior Congress leader Ghulam Nabi Azad had written to the EC accusing Grover of intimidating voters in Rohtak.

Maya bats for rape accused

BAHUJAN SAMAJ Party (BSP) chief Mayawati and SP president Akhilesh Yadav held a joint rally Wednesday and campaigned for alliance and BSP candidate from Ghosi, Atul Rai, who is facing rape charges and has been absconding for over 10 days after a Varanasi court issued non-bailable warrant against him.

Addressing the gathering at Ghosi, the BSP chief said, "Now they [BJP] are in bad shape. In their political selfishness, they have brought up cases that are one or two years old and have forcefully made women level false allegations. Our alliance's candidate has become a victim of this. The BJP is misusing power to give the BSP a bad name. The candidate's family, including his wife, is here to appeal to you to vote for him," she added.

A woman had got a case reg-

istered against Rai on May 1 in Varanasi, alleging that he called her to his home on the pretext of meeting his wife and sexually assaulted her.

Speaking at the rally, Akhilesh claimed, "Fearing defeat, they have directed the police to target the candidate here."

Targeting Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Mayawati alleged, "He is using all kind of

tricks now and I have come to know that he has started talking about his caste. He changes his caste every three-four days..."

Referring to the attack on Congress MLA from Rae Bareilly Tuesday, Akhilesh said, "... In the name of law and order, our CM says go and shoot... In Rae Bareilly, their people learnt the 'thoko neeti', to win the 2P election. Has the BJP adopted it too?"

Pragya campaigns for former judge in Dewas

FORMER JUDGE and BJP candidate from Dewas Mahendra Solanki on Wednesday found support from an unlikely quarter.

Malegaon blast case accused Sadhvi Pragya Thakur hit the campaign trail for Solanki, who resigned recently as a civil judge (class I). Pragya — the BJP candidate from Bhopal — was also the main accused in the murder case of former RSS pracharak Sunil Joshi, who was shot dead in Dewas on December 29, 2007. She was acquitted by a sessions court here after the case was transferred from the NIA court in Bhopal.

Solanki, 35, said there was nothing wrong with "Sadhvi Pragya Didi" campaigning for him because she had been given a clean chit in both cases. "The court has given its verdict and it has not been challenged," he said of the Sunil Joshi murder case that ended in the acquittal of all accused for lack of evidence. Calling it an ordinary case of murder, the NIA had delinked the trial from other terror cases in which Joshi had been named.

"My association with the RSS began in 1999, then I joined the ABVP and then the BJP. I have always been a nationalist. I responded to the call from Prime Minister Narendra Modi who wanted all honest and nationalist to work for the nation and tendered my resignation," the former judge told The Indian Express.

Asked if his ideology had affected his work as a judge, he said all the judgments he gave during his nine-year stint are available in the public domain. "As a judge, I followed all the norms. Show me

one instance where allegations were leveled against me and I will resign from the Lok Sabha," he asserted.

He also sought to dismiss allegations that he may have heard cases regarding the Vyapam case. "Get me a certified copy of my judgment, I will quit," he said.

According to functionaries familiar with campaign developments, Pragya wanted to hold a

road show in Shajapur on Wednesday but was denied permission as the Congress candidate was also scheduled to hold a road show. She then campaigned for Solanki in Ashta but did not speak, reportedly because of a sore throat.

She is a star campaigner for the BJP and will hit Ashta, Dewas, Burhanpur and Khandwa over Thursday and Friday.
